

Memorandum of Understanding

Between

Montana Department of Corrections

And

Montana Federation of Probation and Parole Local 4464


This Memorandum of Understanding is between the Montana Department of Corrections, hereafter referred to as the "employer" and the Montana Federation of Probation and Parole Local 4464, hereafter referred to as the "union".

The parties understand that because of District Court requirements the workload has increased in the Billings Probation and Parole office. Because of this increased workload the employer finds it necessary to utilize temporary workers contracted through a local temporary employment agency. The two temporary contracted employees are performing duties as an Administrative Assistant and assisting in writing Pre-Sentence Investigations. The union consents to the use of these specified contracted services for a period of ninety (90) consecutive calendar days commencing on 3 September 2014. This agreement and the use of contracted temporary workers will expire at the end of business, 1 December 2014.

This Memorandum of Understanding is only for this singular event and does not constitute any past practice or establish a precedent.


